- Set a good example for campers and others including cleanliness, punctuality, sharing clean-up and chores, sportsmanship, and table manners.
- Follow camp rules and regulations pertaining to smoking, use of alcoholic beverages, and the use of drugs.
- Encourage respect for personal property, camp equipment, and facilities.
- Manage personal time off in accordance with camp policy.
- Share in the monitoring and cleaning of the camp buildings at the end of each camp.
- Monitor individual camper well being and health, reporting any concerns to the program director and camp nurse.
- Report all infractions to the camp director in an expedient manner.
