

The True Cost of Camp and our Tiered Pricing Structure

You know your family's financial situation better than we do. As you consider your family's financial situation, please also consider the true cost of camp.

On the camp registration form you will find two prices for each camp. You get to choose the one that best fits your family's ability to pay.

Tier 1: The highest price is the actual cost or the amount we spend during the week of camp for your camper to participate. These costs include the food the people cooking the food and keeping the camp ready for campers, the program supplies, and the training, food and lodging for the volunteer leaders.

Tier 2: This is a reduced price. The Episcopal Church of Eastern Oregon provides Ascension School with financial program support that we are able to pass on to our campers and families.

Tier 3: This is the reduced price with a campership to help every camper young or old, come to camp.

Please carefully consider the amount that your family can afford. If Rate 1 seems comfortable to you, choose it. If you think you can help with some of the bigger expenses of the camps, please choose the higher price. And remember, our practice is that no one is turned away for a lack of funds. If paying for camp is a significant challenge for your family, please contact the priest or rector at your local Episcopal Church or the Ascension School office. We want to welcome everyone to camp.
